Classes in Your Home

You come to me?

Traveling to the leading sewing classes can be costly. Firstly, there is the cost of the class — usually over \$500. Then there's the gasoline if you drive or airfare if you fly. There is also the cost of hotels, food, and special supplies for the class. A class for *just one* person can easily run over \$800; usually more!

In addition to the cost, you usually have to spend one or two days traveling and travel these days can be *so* frustrating.

Now for about the cost of *one person* attending a large commercial class, you have well-known instructor, Kandi L. Christian, a Martha Pullen licensed teacher *in your home* teaching your private group of you and your friends.



How does this work?

Invoke your friends to the classes. Divide the cost of the class among the number of people attending the class. Each person pays just their portion of the class fee. The more people you have attend, the lower the cost per person. Classes are priced by the day. Classes have a different number of days. So, take the cost per day, times the number of days for the class and divide by the number of friends that are attending. For example, if you hold the “Fundamentals of Heirloom Sewing” class, and have yourself and seven friends, the cost for each person would be \$42 per day plus your kit fee.

Each person will also need to purchase a kit for the class that includes all the fabulous fabrics, laces and notions you need. We also supply the thread, special stabilizers, and other supplies specific to the projects that are not usually supplied in other classes. You and your friends only supply your own sewing machines basic sewing supplies.

How is this better?

Classes in your home are smaller and more intimate. You will enjoy *personalized* attention you could *never* receive in a large class setting of 40-60 or more attendees. This means that you will learn *more* techniques with *more* time to finish *more* projects during your class.

What do I do now?

Classes Offered

All classes include hands-on workshops and demonstrations where you learn tips, tricks and techniques to advance your sewing skills.

All classes cost \$300 per day plus the cost of the kits. The kit cost is for all kits for the class.

Fundamentals of Heirloom Sewing - 2 Days

Two full days of the fundamentals of heirloom sewing for those who are just beginning or want to polish their skills. You will learn entredeux joining, pin tucking, lace joining, Madeira applique, reverse Madeira applique and gimp work as you create a puffing pillow with lace and entredeux, a pillowcase with pin tucks and scalloped Madeira hem, and an elegant linen table runner with the perfect mitered corners, gimp work and reverse Madeira applique. Kit Cost: \$95 / Person.

Intermediate Heirloom Sewing - 3 Days

Two full days of more advanced heirloom sewing techniques in lace shaping, gimp work, lace joining, reverse Madeira applique, drawn thread work, working with silk and puffing. You will create a silk sachet/ring bearer pillow with lace shaping, a hanger cover with silk ribbon, puffing, pin tucks, entredeux, and linen placemats with drawn thread work, gimping, reverse Madeira applique. Kit Cost: \$105 / Person.

Heirloom Quilting - 4 Days

In this four day class you will create *and complete* a beautiful heirloom quilt in the class! This fascinating quilt includes a variety of techniques including, but not limited to , lace shaping, Madeira applique, machine embroidery, lace-to-entredeux, lace-to-lace, cathedral windows, sharks teeth, decorative stitching and more. On the last day we will also construct the quilt itself using supplied heirloom quality batting and learn a unique mitered corner technique. This is our most popular class. Kit Cost \$275 / Person.

Heirloom Christening Gown - 4 Days

Here's your chance to create the most *beautiful christening gown, bonnet and slip* made from the finest batiste, lace and silk ribbon. You will use lace shaping, entredeux, baby piping, lace-to-fabric, lace-to-lace and much more in this comprehensive 5 day class. This exquisite gown will remain a treasured family heirloom forever.
